

 Everyone on the board is made aware of the complaint via e-mail.
 The board reviews the complaint and makes a decision if the issue in question is in violation of the Brook Meadows CC&Rs.

3.) If yes, the offending homeowner is contacted via phone, e-mail or a personal visit from board member(s). In extreme cases the board will consult with legal counsel to determine a course of action – up to and including the levy of fines.
4.) If no, the board will contact the person complaining and advise that in their interpretation of the CC&R's, there is no actionable violation.

Brook Meadows is a great place to live. Your board knows that disagreements will sometimes happen and assures you that we will do everything we can to enforce our CC&Rs.
